In selecting articles for publication, the editor gives preference to those of general significance that are well written, well organised, meet article specifications, arrive on or before deadline, and are intelligible to the multidisciplinary *Australasian Drilling* audience.

We prefer articles with Australian content received from ADIA members and magazine advertisers, but we do occasionally accept outside submissions. In line with standard editorial policy, the editor is not obliged to consult the author on article changes. However, as a courtesy, the editor will contact the author if major changes need to be discussed. It is the editor's role and responsibility to ensure that all content is accurate, and obeys the copyright and defamation laws of the states, territories and countries in which it's distributed.

ADIA doesn't under any circumstances guarantee that an article will appear in an issue of the magazine. Articles that are consistently rejected include those that are overly commercial in tone, poorly written or organised, too specialised or obscure, too basic, too long or that cover material already dealt with in *Australasian Drilling*.

We value our members' and advertisers' contributions and make every effort to work with them to publish appropriate content for *Australasian Drilling* magazine.
